Is it possible to live a sinless life? Why or why not.

Death-Read John 11:25-26, John 14:19, Revelation 1:18

Why should Christ's victory over death give us hope?

How should this reality affect our lives today?

Read 2 Corinthians 2:14

If God uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of him everywhere, how should this aroma affect the way we live?
